- Individuals having been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony may not be allowed to take the NCLEX Exam for R.N. Licensure by virtue of the authority of the Tennessee Board of Nursing.
- The Tennessee Board of Nursing reserves the right to deny, revoke, or suspend licensure of any individual upon proof that the individual has been arrested, charged with, convicted of, pled guilty or no contest to, or been sentenced for any criminal offense in any state or county.

Prerequisite Enrollment Coursework: You must complete pre-requisite credit hours prior to enrolling in the nursing program. These courses must be completed successfully with a “C” grade by the end of the current term. If taking these courses at TU, they must be completed no later than the end of the semester.
